Art

Create a design for either wall paper or wrapping paper that is in some way dinosaur /stone age themed. Consider repeating images and shapes to help you. E.G. fossils.

(5 points)

History

Consider a person you know from History who you think showed immense courage in their life. Write at least a paragraph about who the person was, and why you think they were particularly courageous.

(5 points)

Free Homework

Create any piece of homework inspired by the title above.

(5 points)

Maths

Research the Fibonacci sequence, and present it as a diagram or a written sequence. What is the pattern? For extra points, find out how the sequence is related to fossils and other parts of nature and show your findings.

(5 points)

Science

What types of plants existed in prehistoric times? Create a factfile of examples. Why have they survived as long as they have?

(5 points)

Geography

Research where the most famous dinosaur bones have been found and show the locations on a World Map.

(10 points)

Value

Be a 'Courage' detective, and find an example of courage for each member of your family. You may extend your detective skills to your closest friends. Look to see different ways people show their courage.

(5 points)

Design & Technology

Make a dinosaur from a material of choice. Your model can be created with lego, paper, card or any household objects you can find. Extra points if your model has moveable parts.

(5 points)

English

Imagine that a dinosaur has been spotted walking down Uley hill. Write a front page newspaper report for the Stroud News & Journal to explain the incident. Remember features of a newspaper report from last term. Include a picture.

(15 points)

English

Write a short script/story which involves a person meeting a friendly dinosaur.

(10 points)

IT & Computing

Create either of the English homework tasks on the computer. You may use any IT programme to present your newspaper report or script. Practice your best word processing skills.

(10 points)

Treasure Hunt

Create a treasure map with up to 10 clues to help find the treasure. You can make a map of your home/school or even create a fictional dinosaur treasure map.

(10 points)

These tasks are to be completed in addition to home reading, Rainbow Maths practice and Mathematics tasks. Please remember to read regularly and ask for extra Rainbow Maths sheets - we have lots ready for you!

Points for the tasks have been calculated in regards to depth and effort needed to complete the task successfully. We recommend choosing a range of activities across the subject range. If you require any equipment/resources to help complete the task please do not hesitate to ask!
