Maths

Music

The centipede enjoys making up silly songs and rhymes. Create your own funny song which begins with 'l've eaten many strange and scrumptious dishes in my time...' 5 POINTS

Science

Create a bug hotel for your garden or local park and then enjoy watching who comes to stay! 8 POINTS

History

In the story, the peach travels across land, water and through the air. Choose a mode of transport and then share how it was first discovered using a method of your choice. 8 POINTS

Art and Design Create your own sheet of

wrapping paper inspired by the works of Eugène Séguy. 8 POINTS

Design Technology

There are many tasty dishes that use peaches. Research and choose your favourite recipe and then make it for your family to enjoy. **10 POINTS**

Physical Education

Go for a walk through the woods, across a field or across the common. What minibeasts can you find on your walk? Record your results using a tally or chart of your choice. **5 POINTS**

Geography

Imagine that you awoke and found yourself in the giant peach. Where in the World would you travel to? Create a map to show your route and include the distances travelled. 8 POINTS

Languages

We are going to be learning the names for different fruit in Spanish but can you learn the word for peach in ten other languages? 3 POINTS

Any subject!

Create your own piece of work relating to our topic 'It's a bug's life'. 5 POINTS

Be the best you can be!

Do five things this term that take you out of your comfort zone. **5 POINTS**

Religious Education

Investigate where the local synagogues are in Gloucestershire. Write them down and for an extra 5 points, visit one and have your photograph taken outside it. **3 POINTS**

English
