ICT Choose your top 5 favourite places around Uley and take pictures of them. Explain why they are your favourite places. 5 points	Create your own piece of homework linked to the topic 'Home Sweet Home.' 5 points	Science Can you show the 3 different states of matter using everyday items at home? Please complete with adult supervision. 10 points.	RE Create your own representation of the creation story. 8 points.
