Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Spring Term. I hope you all enjoyed a lovely Christmas and managed to find some time to rest and recharge the batteries. ### Topic

The children will be developing their skills and talents as creative writers and creating a portfolio of Macbeth-inspired writing to share during our next 'Open Classroom Morning' on the 27<sup>th</sup> March.
