Please note, at least 90% of the ideas below came from the children!

<b>Freedom and fun</b>  Create a model (using any media) of a building from an ancient African civilisation. <b>10 team points</b>	<b>Love of the written word</b> Research daily life in an ancient African civilisation and write a diary entry as though you were there. <b>15 team points</b> 	<b>Maths, science and analysis</b> Design and carry out an investigation which will find out the affect that exercise has on the heart rate. <b>15 team points</b>	<b>Church and community</b> October is harvest. What is the purpose of the harvest festival and why do we celebrate it within the Church of England? <b>10 team points</b> 	<b>Music and dance</b>  Research traditional African dances and have a go at dancing one. You could film it, or perform in front of the class. <b>15 team points</b>

Compare this to Church of England. What is similar? What is different? <b>10 team points</b> 
<b>Love of the written word</b> Write an acrostic poem using the word AFRICA. <b>5 team points</b> 	<b>Awareness of our place in the world, geographically and socially</b> Research and create a profile of an African country. <b>10 team points</b> 	<b>Awareness of our place in the world, geographically and socially</b> Research the roles and experiences of African countries during the First or Second World War. How will you present your findings? <b>15 team points</b> 	<b>Sport and fair play</b> Which sport or outdoor activity do you think will raise your heart rate the most? Prove it! <b>10 team points</b>
