

As part of our new topic 'Movers & Shakers' we have created a collection of homework tasks below for you to choose from. You must complete a **minimum of 3 tasks**. All the children will have the opportunity to share their homework and have it on display in the classroom. Each task has an assigned number of team points that they can earn – how many can they collect?

<p><b>'Let's Explore the World'</b> Using an Atlas can you find the seven Continents and Oceans? Now can you jump inside your Atlas and use your compass to Navigate to America or another Continent.
