

## Home-School Agreement – September 2015

## Responsible Internet and Technology Use

We use the school computers, the Internet and other technology for learning. These rules will help us to be fair to others and keep everyone safe.

- I will not bring in any technical device including, but not limited to, mobile phones, iPads, DS, etc., unless I am given permission to do so to support learning. In these cases, the school will contact parents / carers to confirm permission.
- If I walk to / from school alone, and carry a phone for safety reasons, this phone must be handed in to the school office for the duration of the school day.
- I will ask permission before accessing any website, unless my teacher has already approved that site.
- I will not look at or delete other people's files.
- I will not bring Flash Drives or Memory Sticks into school without permission. I understand that if one is approved, it will be subject to a virus scan.
- I will only e-mail people my teacher has approved.
- The messages I send will be polite and sensible.
- When sending e-mail, I will not give my home address or phone number, or arrange to meet someone.
- I will ask for permission before opening an e-mail or an e-mail attachment sent by someone I do not know.
- I will not use chatrooms.
- I will never access any social media site unless it is to support learning **and** under the direct guidance of my teacher.
- If I see anything I am unhappy with / not sure about, or I receive messages I do not like, I will tell a teacher immediately.
- I know that the school may check my computer files and may monitor the Internet sites I visit.
- I understand that if I deliberately break these rules, I could be stopped from using the Internet or computers.

All school devices that can be connected to the internet are protected by the Local Authority and the South West Grid for Learning safety procedures.

The school may exercise its right by electronic means to monitor the use of the school's computer systems, including the monitoring of web-sites, the interception of E-mail and the deletion of inappropriate materials in circumstances where it believes unauthorised use of the school's computer system is, or may be taking place, or the system is, or may be being used for criminal purposes or for storing text or imagery which is unauthorised or unlawful.
