Love of the written word Find out about a mountain or river in a different country. Present as a fact file. You can type this and insert images too! 15 points	Love of the written word Write an acrostic poem for 'River' or 'Mountain.' 5 points Write an adventure with a mountain as the setting! 10 points	Maths, science and analysis Can you recreate the water cycle in a bag? Take photos of your investigation. 10 points Create a tally chart of items in your surrounding area (flowers, trees, animals.) Present in your own unique way! 10 points	Freedom and fun  Create a river using mine-craft/ Lego/ natural resources. 5 points Create an astronauts den! 5 points Make a model of a valley with a river, you could make it in a box! 5points	Ideas and imagination What can you find out about the wildlife found on river banks or on the mountainside? You could look at a different location for example the Amazon or the Nile! Present as a PowerPoint. 15 points
