Invent your own ‘language’ where each character is a word and create a dictionary!</p> <p>15 team points</p>		<p>Music and dance </p> <p>Research music and dance styles of (ancient) China.</p> <p>Learn a song/ piece of music/ a dance!</p> <p>Perform it on video. 10 team points Perform it in front of the class! +15 team points</p>
