Literacy


We are beginning to teach the children Phase 2 of phonics using our new scheme Unlocking Letters and Sounds. The children will have a daily 30-minute phonic session learning new phonemes and common exception words. Once these are established the children will be using this knowledge to write CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words. We will be practising their name writing and name recognition and we will be encouraging a love of reading by sending home 2 books every week. A phonically decodable book they can read themselves and a story book to share with family. These will be changed once a week. We will also be enjoying story time every day in our reading area.

Maths

In Maths we follow the White Rose scheme which breaks down maths into small steps for the children. This term the units we will be covering are: Match, sort and compare, Measure and patterns, It's me 1,2,3, Circles and triangles, 1,2,3,4,5 and Shapes with sides. The children will learn through practical activities as well as learning to form the numbers correctly in written form

Communication and Language

Through both classroom and circle time activities, we will continue to build on our ability to listen for extended periods of time, both in small groups and as a whole class. We will learn how to hold conversations and how to respond and ask questions.



Physical Development

We will have PE lessons on a

Wednesday afternoon. Please ensure
your child has a labelled PE kit in
school. This term the children will be
doing two gymnastic units 'High, Low,
Over, Under' and 'Moving' where they
will be learning how to travel, using the
apparatus, creating shapes using their
bodies and making big and small
movements.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be focusing on experimenting with colour using paints and chalks.

The children will be singing rhymes and retelling stories using props and puppets and using their imagination in the continuous provision areas outside.

We will also be taking part in a nativity during December.

RE/Understanding the World

This term we will be thinking about past and present and how things were for children in the past.



The children will be thinking about their own environments, where they live, what their house is like and how they might differ from each other. They will be using stories such as The Three Little Pigs to discuss materials and how some are more suitable for certain jobs than others.

In RE the children will be learning about why the word God is important to Christians and why Christmas is important to Christians
