
Literacy

We are continuing to teach the children phonics using our scheme Unlocking Letters and Sounds. We are currently on phase 4 looking at adjacent consonants, vowel digraphs and trigraphs. The children will have a daily 30-minute phonic session learning new phonemes and common exception words. We will be using our phonic knowledge to now write sentences with a focus on being able to re-read their own work and use capital letters and full stops correctly. The children will also have a guided reading session once a week with children who are reading at a similar level.

Maths

This term we will focus on To 20 and beyond - number patterns to 20, estimating, missing numbers, How many now? - Children build on their understanding as they explore the change structure of addition. Manipulate, compose and decompose: further exploring the properties of shapes and spatial relations. Sharing and grouping They will investigate what sharing is and describe equal sharing as fair and unequal sharing as unfair. Visualise, build and map returning to the concept of repeating patterns.

Communication and Language

Through both classroom and circle time activities, we will continue to build on our ability to listen for extended periods of time, both in small groups and as a whole class. Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will follow the Charanga scheme of work for music to learn pulse and moving in time to music, they will listen to a variety of sounds. They will use a variety of small tools, including scissors and paint brushes and make simple prints. They will begin to show accuracy when drawing and learn what a landscape is.

RE/Understanding the World

This term we will be thinking about developing scientific knowledge through play activities sharing stories and non-fiction books. They will learn about people, culture and communities and the natural world.

In RE the children will be focusing on the question Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians? And after half term; What places are special and why? This will cover many religions and special buildings. We will talk about our favourite stories then look at some of the special stories from the Bible which talk about making a difference to people.
